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Summer Day Camp 2020 Camper/Parent Guidelines (as of 2-20-2020)

Summer Day Camp 2020 Sessions and Fees

- **DUE AT TIME OF REGISTRATION: Non-Refundable Session Deposit:** \$75 per child per session due with complete (both sides with all signatures) registration form for each child and a signed guidelines form for each child
- **Session 1 runs 7/06 thru 7/17:**
- **Session 2 runs 7/20 thru 7/31:** (NO CAMP the day of Dorney Park Trip on 7/21/2020, tickets \$40 each)
- **Session 3 runs 8/03 thru 8/14:**
- \$250 fee per child (less deposits already paid), per session if paid **on or before** June 1, 2020,
- \$300 fee per child (less deposits), per session if paid **after** June 1, 2020.
- Session fees are due the Wednesday before each session begins. There will be a \$25 late fee due if paid after the Wednesday before Session begins.
- These fees include all trips **EXCEPT** Dorney Park, which is \$40.
- We accept check, money order or credit cards. ALL payments in the form of check/money order can be made payable to: "Northern Liberties Advisory Council OR Northern Liberties A.C." We do not accept cash as payment.

Hours

- Hours of Camp: 9AM - 5:30PM Monday thru Friday (except on 7/21/2020 – NO CAMP – Just Dorney Trip)

Ages

- Must have completed kindergarten AND be 6 years of age on or before July 1st.
- Must not be older than 12 years old before July 1st.
- Birth certificates and proof of kindergarten completion are required at time of registration.

Important Dates

- **Date 7/21/2020:** Dorney Park Trip
 - NO REGULAR CAMP ON DAY OF DORNEY TRIP!
 - ALL campers must have chaperone for this trip.
 - ALL families are welcome to join us – Tickets \$40 each for camper families/friends.
 - Bus transportation available for anyone going on Dorney trip.
- **Date 7/23/2020:** Phillies Trip (vs Nationals at 1:05pm)
 - ALL families are welcome to join us – Tickets \$20 each for camper families/friends.
 - Bus transportation available for anyone going on Phillies trip.

Communication

- Please notify us via email at nolibscamp@gmail.com with any issues/questions/concerns.
 - Email is the preferred method of communication.
 - When your child is not coming to camp, please email us to let us know.
 - **Under no circumstances may a parent address another camper or another camper parent in regards to issues at camp.**
- We may also be using a text alert system called REMIND. More information will follow.

Drop-Off

- Children MUST arrive between 9AM and 9:15AM each day.
- If your child arrives after 9:15AM, it is **YOUR** responsibility to find their group and get them to their destination.
- Parents/Guardians must sign children in upon arrival and sign out upon departure.

Pick-up

- Please pick up your child between 4:45PM and 5:30PM each day.
- If you are picking your child up earlier than 4:45PM, it is **YOUR** responsibility to coordinate with his/her counselor.
- Family Swim is from 5PM to 6PM and you are welcome to swim with your camper child/ren at that time.
- Only authorized persons will be able to sign out your child. If someone else is going to be picking up your child, please notify us by giving written/emailed permission that he/she may escort your child home. IDs will be checked!

Late Pick-Up

- **You will be charged \$1 for every minute you arrive after 5:30PM.**
 - This fee must be paid before your child returns for camp the next day.
 - Please note: Payments must be made by check, money order, or credit card.

Dress Code

- Children must wear sneakers with socks to camp each and every day.
- Camp shirts must be worn on trip days.
- Please send your child wearing his/her swimsuit under his/her clothes each morning. A dry change of clothes is recommended for after swimming.
- Do not send your children to camp wearing any earrings or other piercings. This is a safety precaution for the pool.
- Camp activities often include getting dirty (from mud, paint, clay etc.). Please send your child wearing clothes that will allow for this type of fun.

Discipline

- Behavior not adhering to code of discipline may result in:
 - 1st offense: verbal warning or no participation in an activity
 - 2nd offense: discussion with parent
 - 3rd offense: written letter to parent and meeting
 - 4th offense: child will be removed from camp
- Our facility upholds a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for
 - Physical violence to another camper or staff member
 - Proven theft
 - Proven possession of any weapon
- ** No refunds will be given to campers who are expelled due to discipline issues.**

Belongings

- **OUTSIDE TOYS AND ELECTRONICS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT CAMP.**
 - If brought to the facility, they will be held for the duration of the day in the office and will be returned at pick-up.
- We strongly discourage sending your child with money to camp.
- Northern Liberties Recreation Center and its staff are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items including money.

Cell/Mobile Phones

- **ALL PHONES (and any other electronic devices) ARE NOT PERMITTED AT CAMP.**
 - If brought to the facility, they will be held for the duration of the day in the office and returned at pick-up.

Pool

- Children will swim daily from 12PM-1PM, unless on a trip or weather does not permit.
- Proper behavior and safe play is expected while in the pool area. We will discuss water safety with the children but you, as parents, also must discuss water safety with your child.
- If time and space allow, we may swim at other times as well.
- Proper swim attire should be worn in order to enter the pool.
 - NO noodles, swimmys, pool toys etc are allowed in the pool at any time.
 - Only US Coastguard approved lifejackets may be worn at the pool.
 - We recommend that you send your child with goggles. The goggles may not have a nose guard.
 - No earrings or piercings allowed in pool.
- Please send your child with a towel for after swimming.
- Children may also try out for the swim team. Swim team takes place each day from 4-5PM.
- We will offer swimming lessons for the beginner swimmers during camp hours.

Food/Water

- We will provide breakfast and afternoon snack each day.
- Please send lunch with your child each day in a clearly marked bag with camper name on outside of bag.
- Please send a reusable/refillable plastic or stainless steel water bottle with your child with name on bottle.

I have read and understand all of the NoLibs Summer Camp Guidelines/Policies listed above. I promise to abide by the above policies in order to assure a safe camp experience for all participants. I realize that if I do not abide by them, my child may be prohibited from attending camp.
